How to Host a Watch Party Kit

JESUS MISSION – THE MOVIE

Leader Guide

Hosting a Jesus Mission watch party is designed to move beyond passive viewing; the goal is to see hearts stirred to share the Gospel and become part of God's story of redemption in your own city.

1 Planning Your Event

Logistics

Choose a date, time, and location for your gathering.

Targeted Invitations

Whether you are organizing a youth group, a campus ministry, or a local Jesus Club, utilize the template invitations provided to rally your community.

Refreshments

Organize snacks, such as popcorn, to enhance the experience.

2 Suggested Event Schedule

Follow this timeline to integrate the viewing experience with a direct outreach mission, perfect for student and ministry groups:

The Schedule

7:00 PM	Welcome and introduction.
7:05 PM	Watch the documentary.
8:30 PM	A short time of worship and prayer.
8:40 PM	Head out together for night outreach and share the Gospel on the streets, or make future plans to.
10:15 PM	End.

Discussion Questions

- How did the movie inspire you?
- Do you think evangelism is for the everyday believer?
- What holds us back from being on mission with Jesus?
- What could or should we do in our community?
What can we do together?
- Should we start a regular outreach, join an existing one, or even start an official Fireplace outreach?

Take time to figure out a regular rhythm of engaging others with the love of Jesus.

4 Organizing The Outreach

Leadership

Appoint a specific person to coordinate and lead the outreach portion of the night.

Logistics

Choose one or more outreach locations in advance, especially for groups like college ministries or Jesus Clubs looking to reach their specific campuses.

Preparation

Communicate God's heart for outreach and provide guidelines to help your group feel equipped and comfortable before heading to the streets.

5 The Outreach Announcement

**When the film finishes,
begin the outreach time:**

- Encourage everyone with the heart of God for the lost.
- Pair participants into groups of two or three.
- Pray together and agree on a specific time to meet back up.
- Finish with a testimony round to encourage one another, followed by a prayer to ask God to seal the work done in the hearts of those who heard the Gospel.
