Taking Your Next Steps

Seek God's Guidance

Seek God about what you are supposed to do to engage the lost in your city.

Meet the Need

Find the need in your city, and meet the need. Whether it is serving the broken or organizing a street outreach, look for where love is needed most.

Establish a Rhythm

Commit to a regular rhythm. Whether it is once a week or once a month, consistency builds momentum for lasting impact.

PART BEFORE YOU GO (THE LAUNCH)

1. Gather Together

Meet at a central, accessible location at a set time. Greet everyone warmly to build unity.

“Welcome, everyone! I’m so glad you’re here. Before we head out, let’s take a moment to connect. Look around—we are here together on purpose to share the love of Jesus with our city.”

2. Encourage & Build Faith

Remind the group that outreach is simply loving people and partnering with God. Share a quick Scripture, personal testimony, or word of encouragement.

“Remember, we aren’t going out in our own strength; we are partnering with the Holy Spirit. He is already working in the hearts of the people we’re about to meet. You don’t need a perfect pitch—you just need to be yourself. Let’s expect God to move!”

PART BEFORE YOU GO (THE LAUNCH)

3. Form Teams

Break into groups of 2–3. Pair experienced team members with those who are new to outreach.

“Let’s group up into teams of two or three. If you’ve done this before, please pair up with someone who is new. We want to learn from each other and step out together.”

4. Pray & Go

Pray for boldness, divine appointments, open hearts, and unity. Clearly communicate when and where you will meet to debrief.

“Father, we thank You for this opportunity. We pray for boldness, for divine appointments, and for sensitivity to Your Spirit. Protect our teams and let Your love shine through us. See you all back here at [Time]!”

PART AFTER YOU RETURN (THE DEBRIEF)

1. Share Testimonies

Create a safe space where every step of obedience is valued.

“Welcome back! We want to hear what God did out there. Whether you had a deep conversation, prayed for someone, or simply overcame the fear of starting a conversation—let’s share those stories.”

2. Celebrate Everything

What we celebrate, we give permission to increase.
Treat every seed planted as a victory.

“That is incredible! Every interaction matters to God. Let’s celebrate these moments— even the smallest steps of faith are planting seeds for the Kingdom. Thank you, God, for what You did today!”

3. Pray for the Harvest

Finish by placing the people you encountered into God's hands.

"Before we wrap up, let's pray for everyone we encountered today. We bind them to the finished work of the Cross. Holy Spirit, keep drawing them toward You. Thank You for the privilege of being Your hands and feet. Amen."

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
